ORDER

In the Government Order read above, Government had revised the rates of Dearness Allowance admissible to its employees with effect from 01.01.2009. The Dearness Relief to the pensioners was also revised as per the above Government Order. The Board has considered the aspect and is pleased to order that the rates of Dearness Allowance to the employees and Dearness Relief to service pensioners/family pensioners will be revised with effect from 01.01.2009 in line with the revision of rates of Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief ordered vide Government order read above.

DEARNESS ALLOWANCE TO EMPLOYEES

1. The revised rate of Dearness Allowance payable to the employees of the Board with effect from 01.01.2009 will be as follows:-

- 2. The revised rate of Dearness Allowance will be payable to the Part- time contingent employees also on the basis of the pay drawn by them.
- 3. For those who are continuing in the 1998 pay scales even after 01.01.2009, DA will be sanctioned as follows:-

- 4. The accounting and drawal of arrears of DA will be regulated as follows:
 - a. The revised rate of DA due from 01.01.2009 (additional 10 %) will be paid in cash with the salary due for the month of July 2009 onwards.
 - b. The arrear for the period from 01.01.2009 to 30.06.2009 will be drawn and credited to the PF account of the employees along with the salary bill for the month of July 2009 to January 2010.
 - c. The permission to draw arrears along with the salary bill is given in relaxation of Rule 176 of Kerala Treasury Code.
 - d. The procedure as stated in para 4 (a) and (b) will also be applicable to the employees continuing in the pay in the pre-revised scale.
 - e. Where the employee is not eligible to subscribe to any PF Account before 30.06.2009, the drawal of arrears of DA shall be deferred. As and when the PF account is opened, it shall be drawn and deposited in it.

- For claiming the salary for the month of February 2010, a certificate shall be attached to the salary bill to the effect that 'the arrears as per DA revision from 01.01.2009 to 30.06.2009 have been claimed and credited to the PF Account of the employee'.
- q. The procedure as stated in 4(f) will also be applicable to the employees continuing in the pre-revised scale of pay.
- h. Interest on DA credited to the PF Account of the employee will accrue from the 1st day of the month in which the bills are presented to the appropriate authorities.
- No withdrawal, other than final withdrawal, shall be made before the date specified below, from the arrears of DA credited to the PF account.

ORDER

As per order read as 1st paper above, Board had fixed cost of tender forms for the implementation of Hydroelectric projects. Subsequently the Government of Kerala as per GO(P) No. 1/2009/SPD dated.08.01.2009 revised the cost of tender forms in Government, Accordingly the Chief Engineer TC &M brought the same to the attention of the Full Board in its meeting held on 28.03.2009 and it was decided to revise the cost of tender forms for work and supplies in line with the Government Order (Board order read as 2nd paper).

- 2. In this revised order cost of additional copies and cost for the CD format are not specified. Contractors for major works usually purchase additional copies as well as the document in CD format. Now the Chief Engineer (CC) South as per the note read as 3rd paper has informed that while inviting the tender for Mankulam HE Project the cost based on BO read as 2nd paper was taken. Accordingly the Chief Engineer has requested clarification on the above procedure adopted.
- 3. In the BO read as 1st paper the cost is taken as (a) cost of original + duplicate (b) cost of additional copy (c) cost of CD and in the BO read as 2nd paper cost is taken as (a) cost of original (b) Cost of duplicate.
- 4. The issue was discussed in detail by the Full Time Members of the Board on 07.07.2009. The Board also noted that the CD of the tender form is used for editing the price bid in a separate sheet attached to the original and additional tender forms. This is used for reference purpose only and hence a uniform rate of Rs.5000/- + tax can be adopted, and decided:
 - (a) That cost of tender forms adopted by the Board as per BO read as 2nd paper be made applicable to hydroelectric project also;
 - (b) That the cost of additional copy be made the same as that of duplicate copy as there is no difference between the both, and
 - (c) That the cost of CD format be taken as Rs.5000/- + tax (Rupees Five Thousand Plus tax) common for all tenders of HE Projects irrespective of the PAC.
 - 5. In view of the above decision taken by the Full Time Members, orders are issued accordingly

ORDER

Having considered the recommendations contained in Note read as 2nd paper above, the Board noted that ambitious plans drawn up by KSEB for strengthening Transmission and Distribution Networks are sometimes being upset by the single lowest tenderer defaulting on the contract leading to re-tendering and delay in execution of plan works. In order to avoid this Board decided to have at least two vendors for critical items by following the procedure detailed below:

- 1. Negotiation after opening of tender shall be made with the lowest tenderer only. However, L2 bidder will be asked to match with the rate finalised with the L1 bidder after negotiation if the Board considers it necessary. If L2 does not agree to match the rate, L3, L4 etc. will be asked in the ascending order to match the rate with that of L1. When such vendor is added, the purchase order quantity shall be split between L1 and the other vendor in the ratio 70:30. In the event of anyone of the vendors not adhering to the scheduled delivery period, the undelivered quantity shall be cancelled with penalty @ 10% of the cost of the undelivered portion. This quantity shall be added to the quantity of the other selected vendor.
- 2. To add a clause in the tender condition that "The Board reserves the right to add one more supplier at the applicable L1 rate as and when deemed necessary by following the prescribed procedure".

ORDER

In view of the critical power situation in Kerala, Board has accorded sanction to impose power restriction on all HT/EHT and LT consumers vide Board Orders read as 3rd & 4th paper above. Any consumption over and above the quota fixed shall be charged at the actual cost of additional power purchase required, calculated on a monthly basis.

The Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission accorded sanction, vide order dated 18.08.2008 read as 2nd paper above, to impose fuel surcharge to meet the loss sustained to the Board due to increase in fuel charge and UI charges.

The Kerala Water Authority vide letter read as 1st paper above has requested to exempt them from the additional burden imposed by power restriction and to issue direction to field officers for accepting part payment, excluding the cost of purchase power (high cost component).

As per the decision of Full Time Members meeting held on 22.10.2008, the Chief Engineer (Commercial & Tariff) vide letter dated 31.10.2008 intimated the field officers that the Kerala Water Authority may be allowed to remit at normal tariff along with fuel surcharge for the entire consumption without insisting the remittance of entire demand charges till a final decision is taken on the issue on transfer cost of power.

Now Board has examined the note of the Chief Engineer (Commercial & Tariff) read as 7th paper above on the matter and accorded sanction to realize thermal surcharge for the entire quantity and not to recover marginal cost for the excess over quota from M/s Kerala Water Authority provided they give an undertaking that they will ensure equipments with BEE standards are used in their pumping stations and installations.

ORDER

In the Board, the pension claims are calculated as per provisions of Kerala Service Rules. Accordingly, the pension is calculated at 50% of average emoluments subject to the conditions for earning full pension or part thereof, depending on the length of qualifying service. The maximum ceiling on pension will be 50% of the maximum of the highest scale of pay under State Government. As the average emoluments of officers having qualifying service nearly 30 years exceeds the above maximum pay under State Government, the pension calculated for 30 years is limited to the maximum which is then prorated for those having lesser qualifying service.

Now, certain retired officers of the Board have represented that the above method of calculation of pension is not in order and that the pension cannot be fixed on the basis of maximum pension, but on the basis of average emoluments only. The matter was therefore taken up with Government and the Accountant General (A & E). It was clarified that the eligible pension for 30 years of qualifying service is 50% of average emoluments (AE) which is to be prorated if the qualifying service (QS) in less than 30 years. The prorated pension shall not exceed the maximum limit. It is further directed to follow the formula $P = AE/2 \times QS/30$, which is in order.

Having considered the matter, the Board hereby orders to follow the formula,

 $P = AE/2 \times QS/30$

for calculation of pension. It is also ordered to rectify the cases settled otherwise than the above method.

Having considered the Note of the Chief Engineer (Commercial & Tariff) read as paper (4) above, the Board hereby accords sanction to bill the Tea Blending & Packing Unit of M/s. PLL Industries, CC VI/619, Bazar Road, Mattancherry, Cochin 682 002 under LT-VII(A) Commercial Tariff from the date of effecting service connection. Penalty for the unauthorized additional load detected during the inspection on 13-02-2008 may be recovered as per rules under LT-VII (A) (Commercial) tariff.

As the consumer has provision to verify his Maximum Demand for the previous six months and normally applies for increase/decrease in Contract Demand up to his change in requirement, the period of six months required for any change in Contract Demand mentioned in Clause 14 (a) makes much inconvenience to consumer.

Board vide Order read as 1st paper above has authorized the Deputy Chief Engineers of Electrical to grant OTP facility to those Voltage Improvement works where the actual voltage on measurement is found to be less than 150V.

The main objective of KSEB during 11th Five Year Plan is providing quality power to consumers. Low voltage problem still exists in many parts of the state. The Hon'ble Minister (Electricity) has announced in the Legislative Assembly that immediate action would be taken to ensure statutory voltage at all areas by the end of this financial year, that a Voltage Adalath would be conducted during October 2009 at Section level offices and that remedial actions will be taken to improve the voltage at places where low voltage is identified and to complete the process before March 2010. Lots of complaints regarding frequent supply interruptions are also being received.

Board after considering these issues in detail, decided to direct Deputy Chief Engineers of Electrical Circles to conduct Voltage Adalaths at Electrical Divisions / Sub Divisions for the timely and speedy disposal of complaints from consumers. Complaints about frequent supply interruptions may also be considered in the Adalath. Following guidelines are issued for the smooth and successful conduct of the Adalath.

- Voltage Adalath shall be conducted during the period from 1-10-2009 to 31-10-2009.
- A committee shall be constituted with the following members for conducting Voltage Adalath:
 - Deputy Chief Engineer of Electrical Circle
 - Chairperson.
 - Executive Engineer of Electrical Division b
- Member
- Assistant Executive Engineer of Electrical Sub Division Member & Convener.
- The representatives of Local Self Governments such as President of Local Panchavat or 3 Chairperson of Municipality or Mayor of the Corporation whose jurisdiction the Division / Sub Division falls, shall be invited to participate in the sitting and hearing of Adalath as special invitee.
 - b Concerned MLAs shall also be invited as the Chief Guest for the Adalath.
 - Wide publicity shall be given to the time, date & venue of Adalath.
 - Notice may be exhibited in Electrical section, Sub Division, Division, Village Offices, Panchayat, Municipal/ Corporation offices etc for making the public aware that

- consumers can lodge their complaints from 1-9-2009 to 30-9-2009 at Electrical section offices concerned.
- Complaints/representations received shall be registered in the section office and duly acknowledged by the officer in charge of the section.
- The Assistant Executive Engineers of Electrical Sub Division shall fix the time, date & venue of Adalath for each Electrical Section in consultation with the representatives of local self Governments. Time and venue shall be convenient to consumers facilitating their personal appearance.
- 4 The Assistant Engineer in charge of the section shall submit versions of the complaint with a report to the Deputy Chief Engineer through proper channel.
- The committee shall examine the complaint and the versions of Assistant Engineer in detail with reference to facts before the Adalath.
- Consumers shall be heard and appropriate decision be taken in the presence of representatives of Local Self Governments and MLAs.
- The decision of the Adalath may be communicated in writing to the complainants within 7 days after the Adalath.

ORDER

The Government of Kerala in the Government Order read as 1st above, have unified the date of retirement of Government Employees and Teachers as 31st March of every year. Subsequently, in the Government Order read as 2nd, the benefit was extended to Employees of the Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous Bodies, Universities, Corporations and Boards under State Government. In Clause (3) of the Government Order dated 30.04,2009, it was specifically mentioned that in the case of Autonomous Bodies the Order will apply subject to the decision by their governing bodies.

The Managing Committee of the Board has examined the said issue in its Meeting held on 21.05.2009 and decided not to adopt Government Orders dated 24.04.2009 and 30.04.2009 since the KSE Board is undergoing restructuring process, and to examine the matter afresh while settling the employee related issues. Orders were issued accordingly vide paper read as 3rd above.

Government have subsequently issued Notification dated 07.07.2009, amending the Rule 60 (a) of Part I KSR in tune with the Government Orders dated 24.04.2009, through an SRO dated 04.07.2009 read as 4th paper above.

In the Writ Petitions filed before the Hon'ble High Court by the employees of the KSE Board seeking direction to extend the benefit of the above Government Orders, the Hon'ble Division Bench passed an interim order dated 30.07.2009 read as paper 5th above wherein it was held that in view of the amendment of Rule 60 (a) in Part I KSR, Ext.P4 decision of the Managing Committee not to adopt the Government Orders dated 24.04.2009 and 30.04.2009, will have no effect and hence directed the Managing Committee to inform its view regarding the rejection of the amendment brought by SRO No.582/2009, to the Government.

As the Hon'ble Court has directed the Board to intimate the decision of the Managing Committee, the Special Officer and Full Time Members of the Board considered the matter and decided to uphold the decision dated 21.05.2009 of the Managing Committee not to adopt the amendment to KSR applicable to the Employees of the Board.

Accordingly, the Board has intimated the decision to the Principal Secretary (Power), Government of Kerala vide letter dated 07.08.2009, requesting to uphold the decision dated 21.05.2009 of Managing Committee and to issue orders to the effect that SRO.582/2009 published on 07.07.2009

is not applicable to Employees of KSE Board pending finalisation of the restructuring process. The matter was placed before the Managing Committee for ratification of the proposal forwarded to the Government.

The Managing Committee, in the Full Board Meeting held on 27.08.2009, decided not to adopt the amendment brought to Rule 60 (a), Part I KSR as per SRO.582/2009 in the Board, pending finalization of restructuring process and decided to ratify the proposal forwarded to Government as per letter dated 07.08.2009 of the Secretary, KSE Board that the G.O (P) No.261/09/Fin dated 04.07.2009 (SRO.582/2009) is not applicable to the Employees of the KSE Board pending finalization of the restructuring process based on the stand taken by the Managing Committee on 21.05.2009.

ORDER

Physically challenged employees in K S E Board were granted conveyance allowance adopting the relevant Government Orders for implementation in Board vide Board Order read as (1) above. The subsequent revisions made by Government in conveyance allowance were implemented in Board for workmen category and such provisions were included in the Long Term Settlements in 1990, 1995 and 2000. In the Long Term Settlement dated 28.02.2007, the rate of conveyance allowance to the physically challenged employees in K S E Board has been revised from Rs. 200/- to Rs. 300/- in line with the revision in Government.

Since the above revision in conveyance allowance has not been mentioned in the pay revision order of officers dated 12.09.2007 physically challenged employees in officer category are not being paid the conveyance allowance. Many representations have been received to extend the benefit to officers also.

Having considered the above matter in detail, the Full Board in its meeting held on 27.08.2009, decided to extend the conveyance allowance admissible to the physically challenged employees @ Rs. 300/- p.m to officers also with effect from September 2007.

In the light of the unprecedented crisis owing to the accumulation of arrears of Kerala Water Authority, several rounds of discussion were held between the officials of Kerala Water Authority and KSE Board and the modalities for One Time Settlement of dues were mutually agreed upon and were submitted for Government approval. Government considered the proposal in detail and approved the One Time Settlement of arrears in respect of Kerala Water Authority vide G.O. read as paper (1) above, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) Kerala Water Authority will remit to Kerala State Electricity Board, Rs.250 Crores in lumpsum, as 'One Time Settlement' of arrears.
- (ii) Kerala State Electricity Board will freeze the arrears as on 31.03.2008. All fresh remittance made by Kerala Water Authority will be credited towards current dues (not towards arrears).
- (iii) Kerala Water Authority will take measures to pay the current charges regularly.
- (iv) Once the above arrangements are made, the liability of Kerala Water Authority to Kerala State Electricity Board for the arrears incurred on or before 31.03.2008 shall stand fully discharged.
- (v) Kerala State Electricity Board will examine the request for power tariff revision made by Kerala Water Authority and move Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission for approval.
- (vi) Kerala Water Authority has requested for dismantling the electric connection to the abandoned pump houses. The settlement of above arrears will not stand in the way of honouring the request for dismantling of such connection.

The matter regarding the implementation of G.O. dated 26.09.2008 was placed before the Board vide 4th paper above. The Board in its meeting held on 27.08.2009 discussed the matter elaborately and considered the following points.

1. G.O. (MS) No: 45/08/WRD dated 26.09.2008 was issued by the Government in Water Resources Department in furtherance of the discussions held by the Cabinet Committee consisting of the Honourable Minister for Finance, Honourable Minister for Welfare of

- Scheduled and Backward Communities and Electricity and Honourable Minister for Water Resources.
- 2. Intervention of the Cabinet Subcommittee was necessitated based on the request of the Kerala Water Authority to sort out the impasse arising out of huge arrears outstanding from Kerala Water Authority towards current charges and the failure by Kerala Water Authority to remit the current dues.
- 3. Arrears amounting to Rs. 1,102.36 crores was outstanding against Kerala Water Authority (Rs. 707.29 crores Principal + Rs. 395.07 crores as interest @ 24%) as on 31.03.2008 and there was no remittance of current charges for a long period.
- 4. Rs. 250 crores was accepted considering the fact that there was not even a remote possibility of recovering the arrears from the Kerala Water Authority and also in view of the possibility of taking up the balance amount as subsidy claim from Government.
- 5. The amount of Rs. 250 crores remitted by the Kerala Water Authority enabled KSE Board to close the financial year 2008-09 with a cash deficit of less than Rs. 201 crores in spite this being one of the worst years in KSE Board's history in financial terms.
- 6. After the settlement, Kerala Water Authority promised to remit the current charges promptly. Due to the settlement, it has been possible to claim the current charges from Kerala Water Authority at least partially.
- 7. Over and above, Kerala Water Authority and KSE Board are two utilities under the State Government providing essential service of supplying drinking water and electricity.

After detailed and meticulous deliberations. Board has decided

- I. to ratify the action of the Chairman, KSE Board in having accepted the One Time Settlement of remitting Rs. 250/- crores by the Kerala Water Authority in the KSE Board and discharging the Kerala Water Authority from all other liabilities as on 31.03.2008 and in having acted upon the G.O. (Ms) No: 45/08/WRD dated 26.09.2008 issued by Government in Water Resources Department.
- II. to adopt G.O. (MS) No: 45/08/WRD dated 26.09.2008 in the Board.
- III. to work out the actual arrear amount due from the Kerala Water Authority under One Time Settlement Scheme after adjusting Rs. 250/- crores already remitted, as on 31.03.2008 and request the Government for reimbursement as subsidy as per Section 65 of the Electricity Act 2003.

Orders are issued accordingly.

ORDER

The Deputy Chief Engineer, Electrical Circle, Kottayam vide 1st paper has reported that in order to speed up the processing of the applications received under the complete electrification programme of Assembly Constituencies, the Hon'ble Minister(Electricity) had directed to take necessary favourable action in the case of those who have not obtained any building number/permit from the panchayat. At this juncture, the Deputy Chief Engineer has requested clarification whether recommendation of the President of Local Self Government or resolution of the Grama Panchayat can be accepted, instead of building number/permit of Panchayat for processing the applications at Electrical Section Offices.

The Hon'ble Minister (Electricity) has announced in the Legislative Assembly that Service Connection for beneficiaries living at coastal areas without house number shall be given based on Ration Card/Voters Identity Card. The MLA, Aluva Constituency vide 5th paper has requested the Hon'ble Minister (Electricity) to issue necessary orders to effect domestic connection to those who have not obtained any building no./permit from local body.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Board decided to:

- i) Accept resolution of the Local bodies instead of building number/ approved plan/permit issued by Local bodies, for processing the applications for electrifying houses for those who have not obtained any building number/ approved plan/ permit from Local bodies where 100% electrification is being undertaken, considering as a special case.
- ii) (a) Effect domestic service connection to households in coastal areas where 100% electrification is going on and not having house number allotted by Local bodies on the basis of ration cards. The applicant shall be the head of the household who will also produce the voters Identity Card.
 - (b) Obtain an undertaking from the consumer agreeing that Board is at liberty to disconnect the service, if the Secretary of the Local body requests in writing to disconnect the service.

In the Government Order read as 1st above it was ordered that all Government Employees and Teachers who attain the age of 55 years during the course of the financial year would continue in service till the end of that financial year. As per the Government Order read as 2nd above, Government had extended the benefit of the Government Order dated 24.04.2009 to the employees of Public Sector Under Takings/Autonomous Bodies/Universities/Corporation/ Boards etc. with the specific condition that in the case of the autonomous bodies the Government Order dated 24.04.2009 read as 1st paper above would apply subject to the decision by their governing bodies.

Accordingly, the Managing Committee of the KSE Board in the meeting held on 21.05,2009 had considered the matter of implementation of the Government Orders read as 1st and 2nd paper in the Board. Since the Board is undergoing restructuring process, KSE Board had decided vide Board Order read as 3rd above not to adopt the said Government Orders and to examine the matter afresh while settling the employee related issues. Meanwhile Government as per SRO. No.582/2009 amended Rule 60 (a) Part-1 KSR in tune with G.O. (P) No.154/2009 fin. dated 24.04.2009.

A number of WP (C)s were filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala challenging the decision of the KSE Board. In the judgment read as 4th above, the Hon'ble High Court had ordered that the Government shall take a final decision taking into account the views of the Board, whether the employees of the KSE Board should be denied the benefit of the afore mentioned amendment to Rule 60 (a) of Part-I, KSR. In compliance of the said judgment, the Government as per Government Order read as 5th above, has ordered that the employees of Kerala State Electricity Board will stand exempted from the purview of the amendment to Rule 60 (a) Part-I, KSR issued as per SRO. No.582/ 2009.

The Board has examined the matter in detail. In the audit circular dated 25.11.2008 cited 2nd above it was indicated that the arrears on account of pension revision will be disbursed in a time bound manner as specified in clause 16 (1) to 16 (3). However it is seen that inordinate delay has occurred in revising the pension in respect of those who retired on or after 01.07.03 / 01.08.03 and most of them are yet to receive the revised pensionary benefits.

In this context, continuance of clause 16 (2) of the audit circular may create further delay in disbursement of arrears to these pensioners. Having examined the matter, the Board has decided to issue necessary modification to clause 16 (2) of the audit circular. Hence clause 16 (2) of the audit circular is modified as follows.

"The arrears of pension / family pension in respect of Group II shall become due from the date of authorization of revised pension / family pension and paid in lump".

The audit circular is modified to the above extent.

- 3. The rooms allotted/reserved for accommodation in the name of the officers or staff shall not be allowed to their nominees.
- 4. Request for allocation of room shall be sent to this office in advance to avoid confusion.
- 5. The public who wish to occupy Board's Inspection Bungalow shall submit a copy of their ID proof along with their applications for avoiding unauthorized occupation of Board's Inspection Bungalow.
- 6. The Caretaker of the Inspection Bungalow should issue cash receipt to occupants of Inspection Bungalows for payment of rent in order to avoid complaints regarding rent.

For OverHead service line connection provision for strut is to be included wherever necessary.

Cost of works in the distribution sector for which specific rates are not given shall be arrived at as follows:

- (a) Cost of materials as per cost data.
 - (b) Centage charge 16% of (a).
 - (c) Transportation charge, if any.
 - (d) Labour charges. Total cost of work is [(a)+(b)+(c)+(d)]
- II. Supervision charge 10% of IGrand Total is (I + II)
