Sub: Estt: - Representation of Board employees seeking the benefit of Time bound higher grade by counting their War/Military service-reg.

Your attention is invited to the reference cited.

The Government vide letter read 3rd above clarified that the employees of KSEBL which is a Public sector undertaking are not eligible for the benefits contemplated in the Government Order dated 14.09.2015 read 1st above and extending the benefits of the said Government order to the employees of KSEBL is irregular. In pursuant to the Government direction, KSEBL decided not to adopt the said GO and a Board Order was issued vide referred 4th paper above by cancelling the earlier BO in connection with the adoption of the Government Order.

Hence the employees who were under war/military service and got appointment in KSEBL in gazetted and non-gazetted posts are eligible to get the benefit of time bound higher grades by counting their war/military service as per the rules followed in KSEBL prior to the issuance of the Government Order dated 14.09.2015. In effect, reckoning of war/military service for granting higher grade promotion will be allowed only on refunding of mustering out benefits.

Even after issuance of BO read 4th above, representations are transmitted from various field offices for granting time bound higher grades by counting their war /military service to this office and also to other sections creating administrative inconvenience. The field offices are herby directed to scrupulously follow the Board Order read 4th above while preferring representations to higher offices to avoid commotion and unnecessary transmissions of SB/documents between offices.
