ORDER

As per Office Order read as 2nd above, sanction was accorded for providing 2 Nos of 3G SIM card each at rate of Rs. 62/month and 4G SIM card (2GB data plan) at rate of Rs. 1999/annum for the use of six numbers of Electric Vehicle Charging stations at Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Kozhikode and Kannur.

The Deputy Chief Engineer, System Operation Circle has informed as per note read as 3rd above that, there are connectivity issues with 4G net work and issues may happen during payment time as the payment integration is also to be rolled out immediately at EV charging stations.

It is also reported that the Poor connectivity will badly affect the functioning of EV charging station as well as image of KSEBL.

In view of the above, the Deputy Chief Engineer, System Operation Circle has suggested to have Government approved FTTH Plan 749 for EV charging stations, as this provides fiber connectivity and it is a consistent connectivity.

The matter was placed before the Full Time Directors as per note read as 4th above.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in the meeting held on 25.02.2021

Resolved to accord sanction for availing FTTH connection (FTTH plan 749 scheme) at the 6 Numbers of EV charging stations at Thiruvananthapuram(Electrical Section, Nemom), Kollam (Electrical Section, Olai), Ernakulam (Vydyuthi Bhavanam, Palarivattom), Thrissur (110kV Substation, Viyyur), Kozhikode (220kV Substation, Nallalam), and Kannur (110kV Substation Chovva) with an additional monthly financial commitment of Rs. 5940/- and to authorize the Deputy Chief Engineer, System Operation Circle, Thiruvananthapuram to procure FTTH connection.

Orders are issued accordingly.


