Sub:- National Pension System - modification in the Circular dated 10.06.2015 - reg.

As per Government Order cited 1st, it was ordered that the employees who entered into Government Service/Aided Institutions/PSUs/Board/Corporations/Autonomous Bodies etc. which are governed as per Part III Kerala Service Rules, before 01.04.2013 and reappointed on or after 01.04.2013 in PSUs/Boards/Corporations/Autonomous bodies etc which are governed by Part III Kerala Service Rules shall be retained in KSR Part III Pension Scheme subject to rules of the respective institutions. The above Government Order was adopted in Kerala State Electricity Board Limited as per Board Order 2nd cited. Subsequently as per Circular 3rd cited detailed instructions were issued in this regard.

As per the Long Term Settlement dated 28.02.2007 it was decided that employees who entered Board service on or after 01.08.2003, prior service rendered by them in Government or elsewhere will not be reckoned for the purpose of computing qualifying service in the Board.

In the sub clause iv (h) under Circular referred 3rd above, it was mentioned that the service rendered by the above said employees in Government Service/PSUs will be considered for service benefits including pension subject to the rules in force in the Board. The Law Officer vide Note under reference(4) has informed that the above said clause need to be modified to avoid misinterpretation.

In view of the above, the last sentence under clause iv (h) of the Circular dated 10.06.2015 is modified as follows:

'The service rendered by the above said employees in Government Service/PSUs/Boards/Corporations/Autonomous bodies etc will not be reckoned for the purpose of computing qualifying service in the Board.'

The Circular dated 10.06.2015 stands modified to the above extent.
