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Abstract

Establishment – Temporary promotion of Assistant Engineers to the cadre of Assistant Executive Engineer – Cadre Pay – Sanctioned – Orders issued.

ORDER

In order to overcome the shortage of Assistant Executive Engineers in the Electrical and Civil wings, the Chief Engineer (HRM) had promoted 77 Electrical Assistant Engineers and 32 Civil Assistant Engineers to the post of Assistant Executive Engineer temporarily as per Rule 31 of KS & SSR, vide orders read 1st and 2nd papers above. The Chief Engineer (HRM) took up the matter regarding the admissibility of Cadre Pay to the temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers as per note read 3rd paper above.

The Chief Personnel Officer has offered the following remarks in this matter as per note read 4^{th} paper above.

- 1) All the promotions were done as per rule 31 of KS & SSR.
- 2) The temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers are bound to exercise the same duties and responsibilities of Assistant Executive Engineers working in the regular cadre posts.
- 3) The delegation of powers of Assistant Executive Engineers need to be extended to the temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers in order to perform the duties and responsibilities attached to the post of Assistant Executive Engineer.
- 4) The temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers posted in Electrical Sub Divisions are to be designated as Assessing Officer in view of the G.O. (P) No.7/2017/PD Dated 26.09.2017.
- 5) For the smooth implementation of general transfer, all Assistant Executive Engineers shall be treated equally, irrespective of the fact that they are regular or temporary.
- 6) Pay fixation benefits are not eligible to the temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers consequent to this promotion since no higher time scale was ordered to be given to the temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers.
- 7) As per Sub Clause 1(3) of Officers' Pay Revision 2016 (B.O. (FTD) No.746/2016 (PS1/3764/2015) dated 03.03.2016), the Assistant Executive Engineers are eligible for Cadre Pay @ Rs.500/month.

In the G.O. (MS) No.4/2014/PD dated 13.02.2014 granting approval for the temporary up-gradation of 167 Assistant Engineer (Ele.) places as Assistant Executive Engineers in the Board, it was specified that Cadre Pay of Assistant Executive Engineers is eligible to the temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers as well. The above promotions were given as per Rule 31 of KS & SSR. Since the 77 Electrical Assistant Engineers and 32 Civil Assistant Engineers were promoted as Assistant Executive Engineer under the same set of rules, i.e., Rule 31 of KS & SSR, these promotees are also eligible for Cadre Pay applicable to that post. As per the remarks offered by the Chief Personnel Officer, the temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers are performing the same duties and responsibilities as that of a regular Assistant Executive Engineer.

Having examined the matter in detail, sanction is hereby accorded to extend the benefit of Cadre Pay to the temporarily promoted Assistant Executive Engineers at the rate of Rs. 500/month from the actual date of joining the promoted post.

Orders are issued accordingly.
